The **ONLY** people that can be on the TEAM bench are Coaches named on the GAME sheet. The Visiting team must change if shirt colors conflict. One Game sheet will be mailed by Referee to the NSA Office **ONLY** if there are Reports to be submitted – Caution, Dismissal, Special Incident. The Handshake Ceremony should take place at the Start of the Match.

Unlimited player substitutions shall be permitted, during a stoppage of play for the following:

- a. Scoring of a goal
- b. Goal kick
- c. Player injury
- d. Halftime, including extra time
- e. Start of extra time
- f. U8 can change on the fly, no stoppage required
- g. U9 – U10 on all kick-ins
- h. U11 & U12 on all throw-ins
- i. U13 to Senior - On ALL own throw-ins, piggy backing is permitted

Slide tacking is NOT permitted, defined as:

- Leaving your feet to CHALLENGE an opponent, contact is not required
- Slide tackle awards a Direct Free Kick or Penalty Kick
- Careless, Reckless or Excessive force standards apply
- Denying Obvious Goal Scoring Opportunity (DOGSO) still applies
- Exceptions:
  - Goal Keeper challenging to make a save in their own Penalty Area
  - Player sliding to keep ball in play – no opponent nearby
  - Player sliding to stop pass or shot – no opponent nearby

Note: at All CUP games – each team pays one half of the Game fee

- In the event of a tie at the end of play for any Playoff and League Cup game, extra time of two (2) fifteen minute sudden death periods (golden goal) shall be played. If still tied, penalty kicks will be taken as per FIFA rules to decide the winner.
